Many small and medium-sized organisations have a traditional operation lacking extensive budget or staff to initiate implementation. We look forward to a high level conference with excellent speakers and topics. And with room for many discussions!

On January 22, 2007 we offer a Pre-Conference Day to **"Younger Academic Publishers**", who will have an opportunity to meet with internatonal colleagues and who will enjoy pezial tutorials from professional colleagues in the morning and workshops in the afternoon.
