



## The Scenario (15 minutes)


- 1. The audience (citizens) pay taxes to the government.
- 2. The government hands budget to each university. JPY 2,000 for Univ-A and JPY 1,000 for Univ-B.
- 3. Each clerk hands the research funds (JPY 200) to each researcher.
- 4. Each researcher writes a paper and submits it to the publisher.
- 5. Peer-reviewed and accepted.
- 6. "Sign the Copyright Transfer Form and pay JPY 100 as submission fee" says the publisher.
- 7. New season comes and the publisher says "Pay JPY 1,000 for the journal subscription".
- 8. Univ-A can pay and Univ-B cannot.
- 9. The facilitator talk to the audience. "Dr. A seems happy, but really? Dr. A's cannot have Dr. B read his/her paper! And how about you? Originally the money was your tax, but you haven't enjoyed the fruit! The repository will make it better!"
