

 The Interlibrary Document Delivery Service (ILDD) is getting replaced by Big Deals, Green and Gold OA.


Institutional Repository	Interlibrary Document Delivery
Once deposited, available forever	Copy again and again on requests
One click access	Offer and wait
Open access, of course!	35 JPY per a page in Japan which is nothing more than the copy and postal fee (NOT pay ILL/DD staffs)
Authors' action for readers	Interlibrary
Authors could know how frequently it's downloaded	Authors neglected!

- However, there still remain demands anyway. Who, what and how to do?
- A case of Otaru University of Commerce (OUC).
 - 1. An ILDD request comes and the library copies and sends it.

If it is OUC author's paper,

- The library asks the author to deposit it to OUC repository.
- The paper is self-archived and will never be requested via ILDD.

To accelerate the attempt, OUC undertakes ILDD requests for OUC author's papers at no charge.



More IR stuff increased, more the ILDD decreased !!

Features for getting populated:

- 1.Notifying the researchers the ILDD demands and ask self- archiving (described in this poster).
- 2. Notifying the authors how often their papers are downloaded by monthly e-mail reports.
- 3. Proxy editing of the UR Researcher Tools for busy researchers.
- 4.Commending every 100th paper with author interview.
