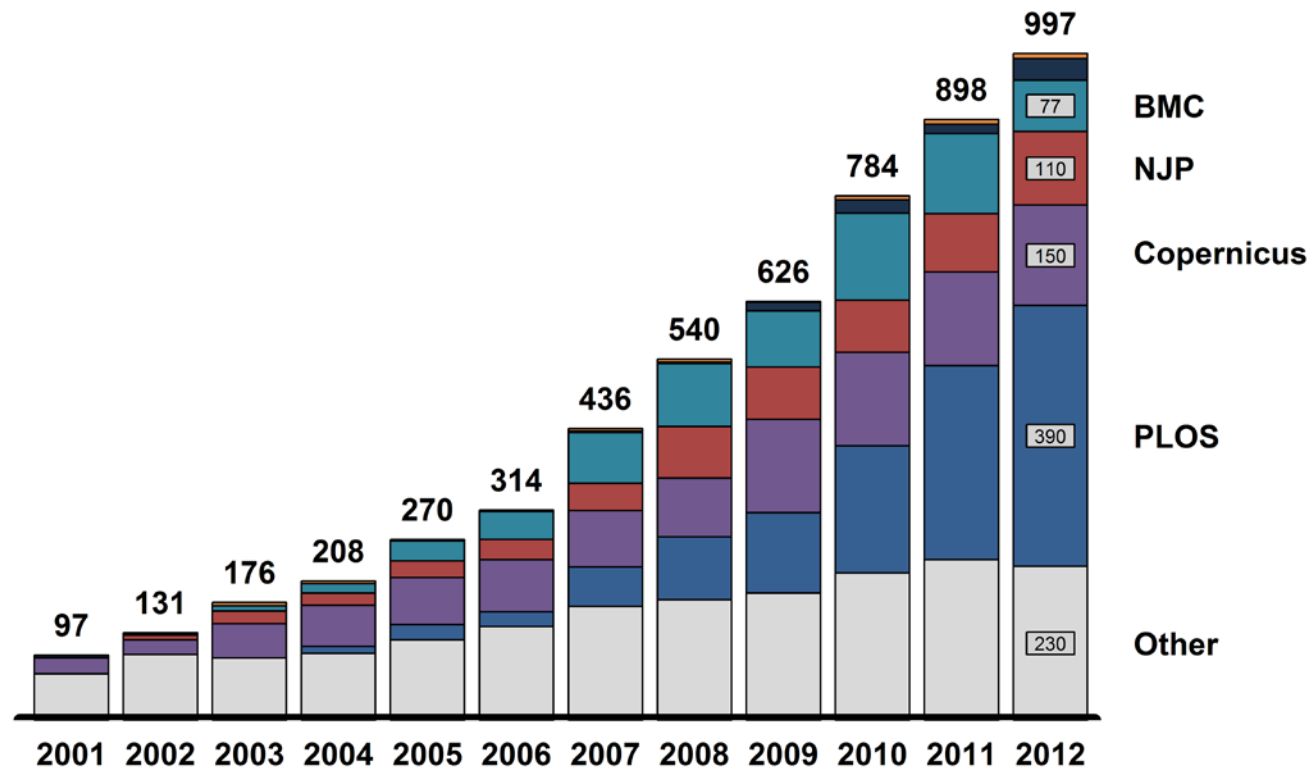

- Abbau administrativer Hürden für MPG-Autoren
- Logische Erweiterung des bibliothekarischen Serviceportfolios: Von „read-access“ zu „write-access“

Ziele (strategisch)

- Umstellung des Publikationsmarktes auf OA ist angestrebtes und erwartetes Ziel
- Erforderlich sind deshalb vollständiges Kostencontrolling (Finanzierung von Lizenzen und APCs aus einem Etat) sowie die Entwicklung von Geschäftsgängen, Prozessen, Kriterien...

Publication Fees
