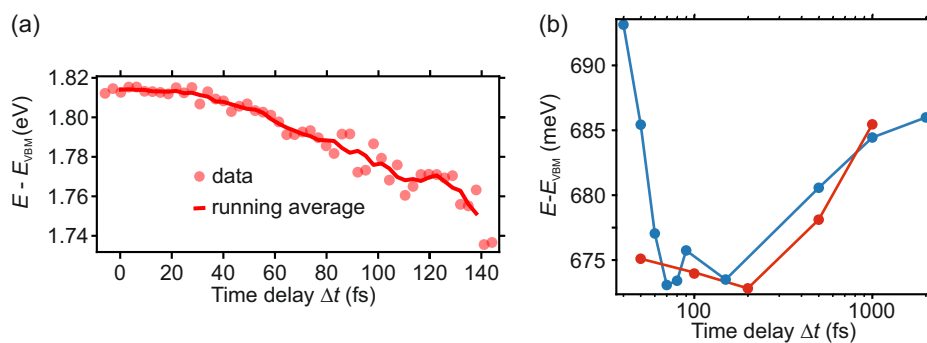
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Suppl. Fig. 1. (a) Energetic position of signal S obtained by fitting Gaussian functions to the differential PE intensity (compare Fig. 2c). (b) Energetic position of signal TT in the time scale 50 fs to 2000 fs obtained in the same way as (a).
