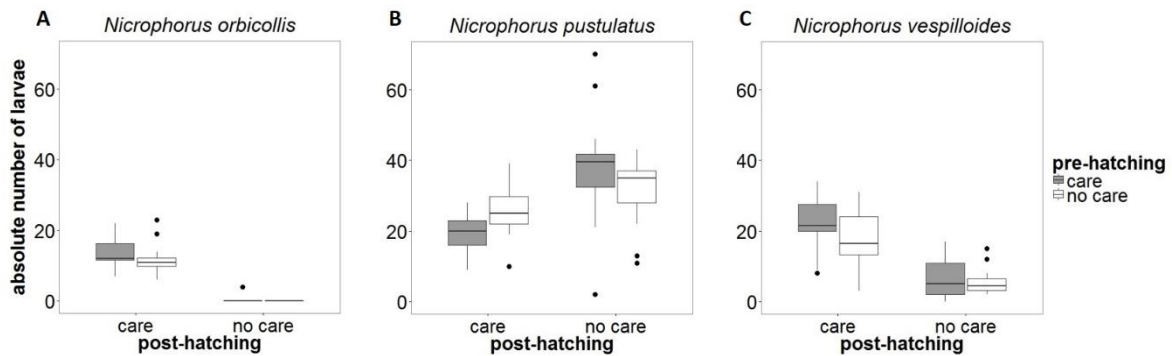


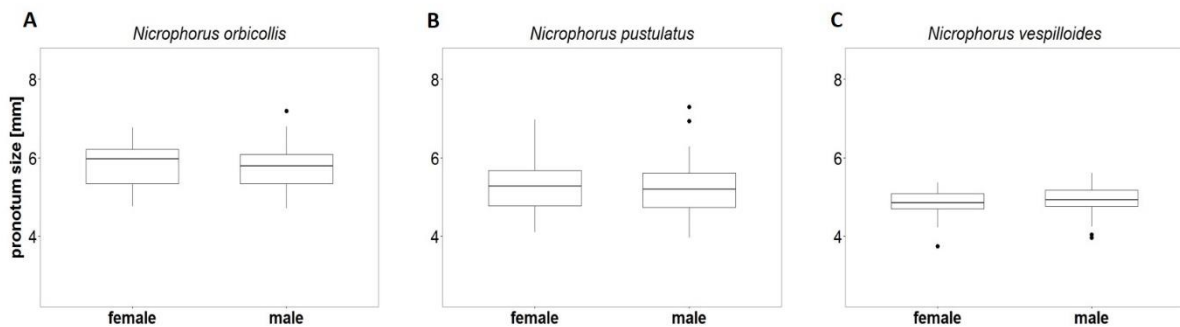

Supplementary Figure S1. Absolute number of larvae surviving to dispersal. (A) *N. orbicollis*: $n = 65$. (B) *N. pustulatus*: $n = 72$. (C) *N. vespilloides*: $n = 71$. Boxplots show median, interquartile range, minimum/maximum range. The dots are values that fall outside the interquartile range ($> 1.5 \times$ interquartile range).



Supplementary Figure S2. Pronotum size (mm) of females and males. (A) *N. orbicollis*: n = 33. (B) *N. pustulatus*: n = 72. (C) *N. vespilloides*: n = 66. Boxplots show median, interquartile range, minimum/maximum range. The dots are values that fall outside the interquartile range ($> 1.5 \times$ interquartile range).
